

Self Plus One

Enrollees covering themselves and one other eligible family member may choose either the “Self Plus One” or “Self and Family” enrollment type, whichever has a lower premium. You should decide which enrollment type is best for you.

FEHB enrollees can make changes during Open Season. Outside Open Season, you may be able to change your enrollment if you experience a qualifying life event. To change enrollment types, you must change your enrollment by following Step 3 above.

Why Senior Advantage for Federal Members may be right for you

If you decide to enroll in Senior Advantage for Federal Members, you'll get better benefits than with your FEHB coverage alone.

Introducing Standard Senior Advantage 2 for 2020

High Option and Standard Option members have 2 great Medicare health plan choices:

Senior Advantage 1: Lowest copays for most covered services, plus extras like dental coverage and an eyewear allowance.

Senior Advantage 2: We reimburse you for the standard Medicare Part B premium you pay – up to \$1,500 each year – and you get lower copays for some services, plus extras like the Silver&Fit[®] fitness program.

Basic Option members also get better benefits

Basic Option members who enroll in Senior Advantage get great benefits, including no deductible, lower costs for most services, and an eyewear allowance.

How can you sign up for Senior Advantage for Federal Members?

To enroll in Senior Advantage for Federal Members, you must have Medicare Parts A and B (or Part B only) and then complete a Senior Advantage Group Election Form and mail it to Kaiser Permanente. If you choose to enroll in Senior Advantage 2, you'll need to provide proof of your Part B premium every year.

We'll enroll you in the plan option that matches the Kaiser Permanente FEHB option you have now. For example, if you're a Kaiser Permanente Standard Option member, you'll be enrolled in Senior Advantage for Federal Members Standard Option. When you become eligible for Medicare, you may be able to change your current plan or option. To learn more about making enrollment changes outside of Open Season:

Kaiser Permanente is an HMO plan with a Medicare contract. Enrollment in Kaiser Permanente depends on contract renewal. To join a Kaiser Permanente Medicare Health Plan, you must reside in the Kaiser Permanente Senior Advantage service area in which you enroll. You must pay the Medicare Part B premium to join a Kaiser Permanente Medicare health plan. Enrolling in Senior Advantage for Federal Members will not affect the benefits you receive through the Federal Employees Health Benefits (FEHB) Program, although the network and other rules of Medicare may apply.

Quality vision and dental coverage*

When you join Kaiser Permanente, you get additional discounts and services.

Eyewear

High Option members get a 25% discount on eyeglasses and contact lenses at Vision Essentials by Kaiser Permanente Optical Centers.

Dental coverage

You can choose from 2 dental plans to supplement your health coverage:

- Kaiser Permanente Insurance Company (KPIC) and administered by Delta Dental of California. With this plan you have the freedom to see any licensed dentist you choose.
- DeltaCare® USA and administered by Delta Dental. You'll choose a dentist from the DeltaCare USA network with this HMO plan.


